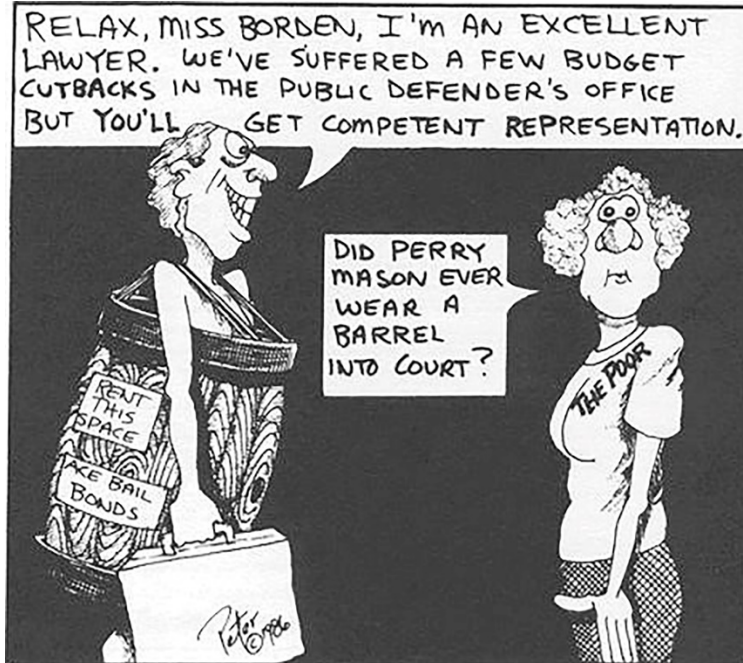


***Gideon v. Wainwright* / Cartoon Analysis**
