

## **Supreme Court of the United States**

Reversed the decision of the New York courts because the Constitution gives only Congress, not the states, the power to regulate interstate commerce.

*Gibbons v. Ogden* (March 2, 1824)



## **Court of Errors, New York**

Upheld the decision of Court of Chancery ordering Gibbons to stop operating his boats.

*Gibbons v. Ogden* (1820)



## **Court of Chancery, New York**

Aaron Ogden files a complaint against Thomas Gibbons asking the Court to stop Gibbons from operating his boats from New Jersey to New York and the court issues the order for Ogden.
